City Of Lampasas Ordinance 1559

Effective October 1, 2018, the City Of Lampasas amended fees, to include Appendix A, which includes alarm permit fees. Any resident or business that does not have a permit for their alarm system within ninety (90) days of this notification could be fined. New alarms must be permitted within thirty (30) days of installation. Note: A separate permit is required for each alarm installed in a separate alarm location / site.
