- Both Hanna Pool and Hancock Pool are ready for the season – had a lot of repairs at Hanna Pool due to the winter storm
- Only opening Hancock Pool during Memorial Day weekend since lifeguards are new this year
- Hanna Spring
- TML inspections – TML Representative will be here on June 7 to inspect water slide and do various site visits
- Storm damage
  - Lost several large trees in the parks due to recent heavy rains
  - Roll up doors at 580 Complex maintenance shop damaged by strong winds
  - 580 Complex – vault door on back flow preventer was blown off by strong winds
- Little League has almost 500 kids signed up this year
- Kid Fish will be June 4-5, 2021
- Proposed locations for retired flag boxes are Cemetery and Fire Station
